- Expect that all relationships with individuals representing the charity will be dealt with professionally at all times.
- Have easily available the agreed procedures for making and responding to complaints.
- Be assured that Clowns without Borders Ireland complies with data protection and GDPR legislation
- Have the opportunity for any names to be deleted from mailing lists and to be assured that we will not share the mailing lists with third parties.
- Receive prompt, truthful and forthright answers to questions you might about us.
